ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

High School Seniors can apply
Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA Must be a Clark County resident
Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours to receive the stipend
Must show proof of financial need. Applicants must have filed Free Application for Student
Aid (FAFSA) and must attach a copy of Student Aid Report (SAR) to this application,
which shows parent's income and parent's contribution (EFC) Tax return may be
requested.

Must be currently enrolled in a college or professional school.

Must include official copy of school transcript

Must provide two letters of recommendation on professional letterhead

Must write a two-page essay for the selected scholarship award (see above), double spaced; one-inch margins, Arial Narrow or Times New Roman Font style; font size, 12.
